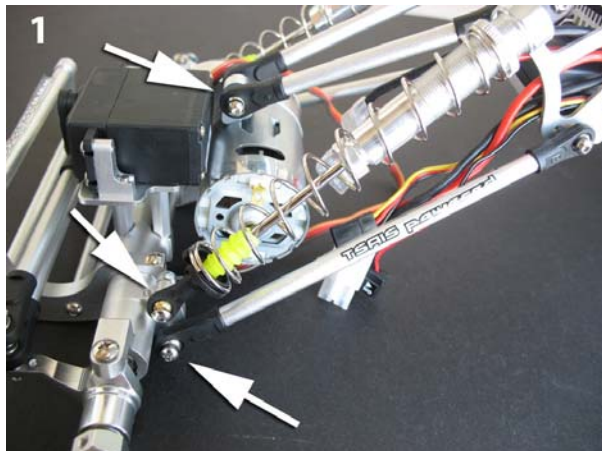

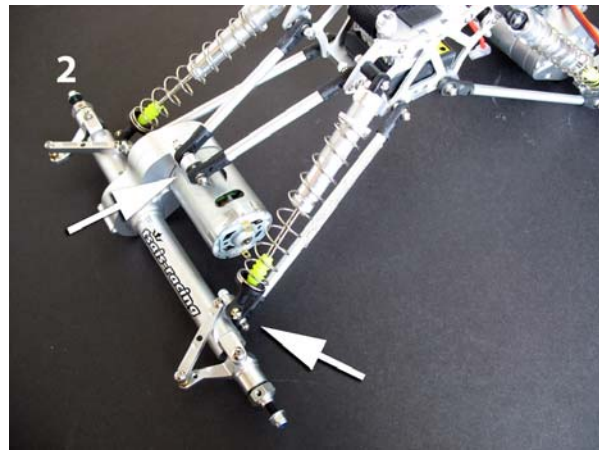

Equipments and tools needed: 2-channel radio, battery pack, charger, side cutters, double sided tape, and zip ties.

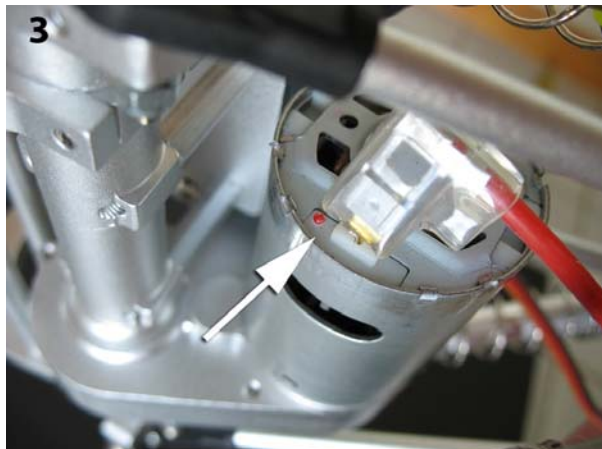
Installation instructions:



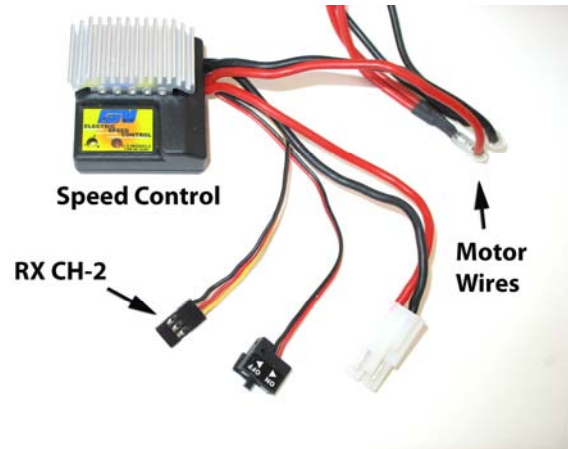

Front axle: Install the links and shocks to the designated positions on the front axle as shown.

Rear axle: Install the links and shocks to designated positions on the rear axles as shown.

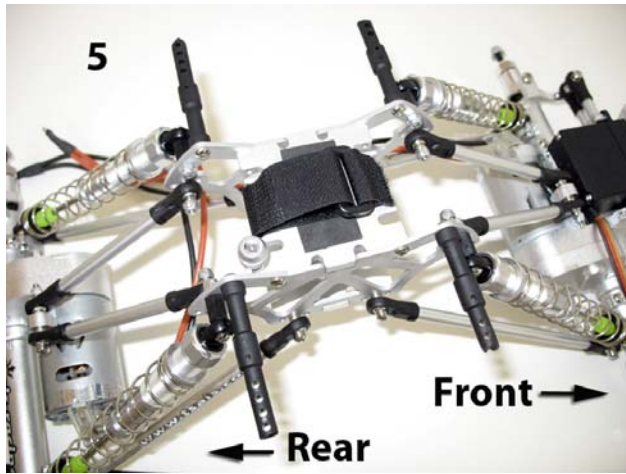

CAUTION: the motor +/- terminals are soft, so use extra caution when connecting the wires. Front motor: Red (+) wire connects to the terminal that is marked red and the black (-) wire connects to the other terminal. Rear motor: Black (-) wire connects to the terminal that is marked red and red wire connects to the other terminal (opposite of the front).



Speed control: it has been installed onto the lower deck of the chassis, so plug the RX CH-2 plug into the receiver CH2 hole, connect the motor wires, and then attach the on-off switch onto the chassis side plate with double sided tape.

Read the Operating Instructions for connection, running the vehicle and warranty information.



Install the body posts onto the chassis plates and trim them to fit the body. You will need 4 holes in the rear posts, and 2 holes in the front posts.



Mount the tires, put on the body and you are ready to claw!

*The battery pack (NOT included) should be placed on the upper deck of the chassis and secured with the Velcro tape. Make sure all the wires are secured on the chassis and will not interfere with the suspension system.



Before mounting the body, install a body clip to the second outer most holes on each of the body posts. After putting on the body, insert the clips to the outer most holes to secure the body.
